



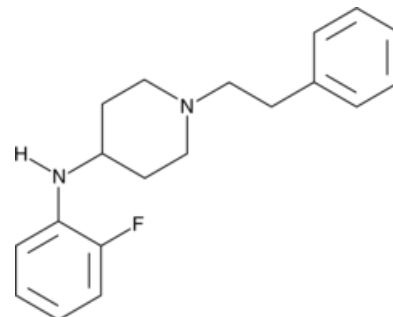

It is also a potential metabolite of these compounds based on the published metabolism of fentanyl.<sup>{39266,40111,32577,39265,39267}</sup> At the time despropionyl *ortho*-fluorofentanyl (CRM) (Item No. 26427) was made available for purchase, specific metabolism data had not been published.
